Easter is on the horizon and I will need to enlist volunteers to help host our annual Easter Egg Scavenger Hunt. This event is special to all of our NHCC children and is also an enjoyable first time experience for any visitors that we might receive. Here is the run down:

10:00 – 10:30am Family Worship Time (children attend our song service with their families.)

10:30 – 11:30am Children will be dismissed into the Fellowship Hall. We will divide the kids into two age- specific groups. Each group will do a rotation of: 1. A Bible Lesson (Resurrection of Jesus). 2. A special souvenir Easter craft and 3. A Scavenger Hunt in which the kids are led through 5 themed classrooms to collect plastic eggs with candy in them! We will follow up with a time of prayer and then return them to their parents.

Our ReSet team handles the egg hunt but I need adult helpers to handle the craft. I also need people to donate the candy for the plastic eggs. Lastly, I need five volunteer teams to create, and decorate the five classrooms. Past room themes have been: Spring, Underwater, Glow-in-the-dark, Zoo, Obstacle Course, etc. The kids love the rooms and don't mind if the same themes are done. I think the obstacle course has been done every year! They love it!

This Sunday I will distribute bags of 50 plastic eggs to be stuffed. We do ask that you secure them with a small piece of Scotch tape. There is not a lot of time to hide the eggs and they will need to be secure if they are tossed into the room:) Please contact me if You have any questions or ideas!
