OT Prohibitions

“You shall not lie with a male as with a woman; it is an abomination.”

Leviticus 18:22, ESV

“If a man lies with a male as with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination; they shall surely be put to death; their blood is upon them.”

Leviticus 20:13, ESV

1. The OT is No longer Binding on Christians
2. Same-Sex Prohibitions Address Nonconsensual Sex

There's Nothing in Leviticus 18:22 & 20:13 That Limits the Prohibition to Acts of Sexual Exploitation

“If a man practices homosexuality, having sex with another man as with a woman, both men have committed a detestable act. They must both be put to death, for they are guilty of a capital offense.”
Leviticus 20:13, NLT

Many Christians Assume That the Sin of Sodom
(Gen. 19:1-10) Was Homosexuality. This Is Not
True.

“Sodom’s sins were pride, gluttony, and laziness, while the poor and needy suffered outside her door. She was proud and committed detestable sins, so I wiped her out, as you have seen.” *Ezekiel 16:49–50, NLT*

NT Prohibitions:

“For this reason God gave them up to dishonorable passions. For their women exchanged natural relations for those that are contrary to nature; and the men likewise gave up natural relations with women and were consumed with passion for one another, men committing shameless acts with men and receiving in themselves the due penalty for their error.” *Romans 1:26–27, ESV*

“Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor men who have sex with males, nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God ***(Authors Translation 1 Cor 6: 9– 10).***”

Malakoi: The Passive Male Partner in Homosexual Intercourse

“Understanding this, that the law is not laid down for the just but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and sinners, for the unholy and profane, for those who strike their fathers and mothers, for murderers, the sexually immoral, men who have sex with males, enslavers, liars, perjurers, and whatever else is contrary to sound doctrine ***(Authors Translation 1 Timothy 1: 9– 10).***”

Arsenokoites: A Male Partner in Homosexual Intercourse
