The Church Is Full of People Who Have Been Conformed to a Pattern of <u>Religious Behavior</u> but Not Transformed by the <u>Holy Spirit</u> of God

I Need a Vision of Change

God Wants Me to Be Conformed to The Image of His Son

What Would Being Conformed to The Image of Christ Look Like?

1. The Good News is That God is Already at Work in Me

"And we all... are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the Spirit." 2 Corinthians 3:18, ESV

"And I am certain that <u>God, who began</u> the good work within you, <u>will continue his work</u> until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns." *Philippians 1:6, NLT*

2. I Pick Up My Cross and Follow Him

"Those who come to me cannot be my disciples unless they love me more than they love father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and themselves as well. Those who do not <u>carry their own cross and come after me</u> cannot be my disciples." Luke 14:26–27, GNB

3. I Seek God with An All-Consuming Passion
