God Is Serious About My SIN

⁹ But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. ¹⁰ If we claim we have not sinned, we are calling God a liar and showing that his word has no place in our hearts.

^{2:1} My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous. ² He himself is the sacrifice that atones for our sins

Some People Mistakenly Take **2b** to Mean
"Universal Salvation"

Now Look at Verse 3:

³ And we can be sure that we **know** him if we **obey** his commandments

What Does All This Mean to Me?

John Is Letting Me Can Know If I Am Really Saved:

I Obey the Word of God

⁵ But those who obey God's word truly show how completely they love him. That is how we know we are living in him. ⁶ Those who say they live in God should live their lives as Jesus did. *1 John 2:5-6, NLT*
