If I Love the World, I Don't Love God

¹⁵ Do not love this world nor the things it offers you...

In 1 John 2 "World" refers to...

"The world would love you as one of its own if you belonged to it, but <u>you are no longer part of the world</u>. I chose you to come out of the world, so it hates you." John 15:19, NLT

Love for The World Pushes Out Love for God
