Understanding the Difference Between Gender and Sex

Sex Simply Refers to One's Biological Sex

Biological Sex is Binary: Male - Female

What Does the Bible Say About Sex and Gender?

1. The Bible Only Identifies Two Sexes: Male and Female

"God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them." *Genesis 1:27, ESV*

2. The Bible Doesn't Consider Sex and Gender to Be Two Totally Different Aspects of What It Is to Be Male or Female

There Are Prohibitions:

Against Cross Dressing

“A woman shall not wear a man’s garment, nor shall a man put on a woman’s cloak, for whoever does these things is an abomination to the Lord your God.” Deuteronomy 22:5, ESV

Against Gender Confusion

“Does not nature itself teach you that if a man wears long hair it is a disgrace for him,” 1 Corinthians 11:14, ESV

The Bible Asserts That the Male/Female Binary Is A Part of God’s Creative Order

1 Corinthians 11:2-16

“But I want you to understand that the head of every man is Christ, the head of a wife is her husband, and the head of Christ is God.” 1 Corinthians 11:3, ESV
